## World Handwashing Day Promoting Healthy Habits

# TEACHERS TRAINING

## Three-Day Pedagogy Training Enhances Teachers' Skills at GHS Basti Mithu

Moawin Foundation organized a comprehensive three-day pedagogy training at Government High School, Basti Mithu, to strengthen teachers' professional skills and classroom practices. The sessions were conducted by Mr. Aliya R. Massey, an expert trainer from the Ali Institute of Education, Lahore.

On the first day, teachers learned about activity-based learning and lesson planning and implementation, gaining practical insights to make classes more engaging. The second day focused on classroom management strategies and questioning techniques to enhance student participation and maintain a productive learning environment. On the final day, participants explored reading and writing strategies, blended learning, and effective assessment methods for improved teaching outcomes.



## Moawin Foundation and DIL Pedagogy Training Course

Moawin Foundation, in collaboration with Developments in Literacy (DIL), successfully completed Phase 1 of the Arranged Pedagogy Course, a three-day intensive teacher training program. Fourteen dedicated teachers participated, gaining transformative skills in student-centered teaching, classroom management, and innovative lesson planning. ## Innovative Fruit Dehydration Activity Revives Kilao Making in Gulmuti, Ghizer

A fruit dehydration and preservation activity was held at Gulmuti, Ghizer, where participants explored innovative ways to prepare Kilao. Replacing the traditional thread with mould sets made the process more hygienic, efficient, and appealing to buyers. This creative adaptation simplified production and was warmly appreciated by participants and the local community for preserving cultural heritage through improved practices.



## Two-Day CPR Training Empowers VTI Students in Sheikhpura

Moawin Sheikhpura, in collaboration with Rescue 1122, organized a two-day Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) training for VTI students. Rescue officers demonstrated lifesaving techniques, including chest compressions and rescue breaths, guiding students on proper hand position, compression depth, and timing. Participants actively practiced under expert supervision, gaining practical skills and confidence to respond effectively in emergency situations.
