Iqbal Day Celebrated Across Moawin Schools

Moawin's adopted schools marked Iqbal Day with thoughtful and engaging activities. Teachers spoke about Allama Iqbal's philosophy and his lasting impact on education and society. Rescue Awareness Session Empowers Students at People's School Ghotki

Grade 9 and Matric students, along with staff at People's School Ghotki, participated in a Rescue Awareness Session led by Mr. Muhammad Awais (Regional Head Sukkur) and Mr. Muhammad Saqib (District Head Ghotki). The session covered critical topics such as Road Safety, CPR, Dog & Snake Bites, and emergency response at home, equipping students with life-saving knowledge and confidence.

Eye Camp at IMSG E-8/3 Supports Students' Vision

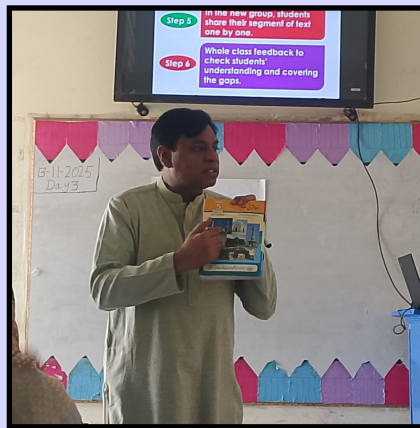
Moawin Foundation, in partnership with Farooq Hospital, organized an Eye Camp at IMSG (VI-X) E-8/3, Islamabad, providing free eye screenings for over 200 students and staff. On average, four students per class were found to have weak eyesight, enabling timely support and prescriptions for better learning.



TEACHERS TRAINING

Moawin Foundation and DIL Pedagogy Training Course

Moawin Foundation, in collaboration with DIL (Developments In Literacy), successfully conducted a 4-day intensive Teachers' Training (Module 2) at the MF-adopted Government Primary School, Qila Mian Singh, Nankana Sahib. The program focused on mastering lesson planning, helping teachers set clear learning objectives and design engaging, inclusive activities for diverse learners. Through classroom observations, interactive workshops, peer discussions, and practical exercises, teachers strengthened their skills to enhance student engagement and learning outcomes. This initiative reflects Moawin Foundation's ongoing commitment to improving the quality of education in underserved communities.



5-Day ECCE Teachers' Training Kicks Off in Attock

A 5-day Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) training program has commenced at the GBTI office in Attock for teachers from Moawin Foundation-adopted schools. Organized in collaboration with Moawin Foundation and GBTI, the training aims to equip educators with essential skills and techniques to foster holistic development and engaging learning experiences for young children.



COMMUNITY RELIEF INITIATIVES

Seven New Homes Completed for Flood-Affected Families in Shigar & Skardu

With the generous support of the Zahidi Family, Moawin Foundation has completed the construction of seven homes for the most vulnerable flood-affected families across three locations in Gilgit-Baltistan. This includes five homes in Doghro, Shigar, one home in Nislo, Shigar, and one home in Hoto, Skardu. The inauguration ceremony in Doghro was attended by Assistant Commissioner Shigar, Mr. Arif Hussain, and Assistant Director GBDMA, Mr. Haroon Gul, who reviewed the newly built houses and acknowledged the timely and quality completion of the project.

The fully furnished shelters were handed over to deserving families, giving them a safe place to rebuild their lives. The Assistant Commissioner, GBDMA team, and community members expressed deep appreciation for the donors—the brothers of the Zahidi Family and also acknowledged the dedicated efforts of Moawin Foundation in bringing this important initiative to completion.
