# PAKISTAN FIRST ECO-FRIENDLY CLASSROOM IN TAXILA

Moawin Foundation, in partnership with the Punjab Education Foundation and with the support of Hashmi Foundation, established Pakistan's first eco-friendly classroom at Government Boys Primary School near Malpur, Taxila. Designed and constructed with the support of the Heritage Foundation, the bamboo-based classroom follows a zero-carbon model, using low-carbon natural materials with maximum natural light and ventilation. The classroom also includes an Early Childhood Care Education setup equipped with child-friendly educational tools. The initiative marked an important step toward sustainable school infrastructure and is viewed as a pilot model for replication across other schools in Punjab. We're grateful to Mumtaz Hashmi Foundation who are supporting this school.
