Relief Efforts in District Ghizer

On August 18, 2024, heavy flash floods devastated several villages in District Ghizer. In collaboration with the Gilgit-Baltistan Disaster Management Authority (GBDMA), Moawin Foundation supported relief efforts by distributing food packs to affected families.



Professional Development of Teachers

Ghanche and Shigar Teacher Workshops

A Refresher Teacher Training was conducted for three batches of teachers in District Ghanche and Shigar in which 182 teachers participated, across five clusters in Baltistan. The training on pedagogy and Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) was guided by expert trainers from the Education Department Skardu and AKU. The sessions covered holistic development, lesson planning, child safeguarding, and assessment strategies.



Professional Teaching Knowledge Workshop

Moawin Foundation, in collaboration with the American Board, conducted an 8-day workshop on Professional Teaching Knowledge. 30 female teachers from Moawin-adopted schools participated, exploring continuous improvement cycles and creating development plans.

Visit to Baltistan
