

EMPOWERING GIRLS THROUGH SPORTS




A sports competition organized at the MF-adopted school PSP Ubauro, in collaboration with SEF.


EQUAL ACCESS TO AFFORDABLE TECHNICAL, VOCATIONAL AND HIGHER EDUCATION

MF has been providing essential facilities to its students, including, but not limited to, infrastructural development and school supplies such as uniforms, books, and bags to support consistent school attendance. Parents and community members expressed their gratitude to Moawin Foundation and the donors for their generous support and compassion.

At Moawin, our primary goal is to provide education and opportunities for women and youth to enable them to acquire knowledge and income-generating skills through our vocational training programs in different regions.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude for the generous contributions of Dr. Farrukh Hasnain and their family in providing warm clothing to our students in two Vocational Training Institutes (VTIs) in Qila Mian Singh, Nankana Sahib. These acts of kindness contribute to the broader aim of Moawin, making a positive difference in the lives of individuals and communities we serve.



Social Welfare and Relief

In collaboration with IHHNL, MF carried out social welfare and relief activities in KPK and Kashmir from December 22nd to 26th, 2023. These efforts reflect our commitment to contributing to SDG 1 (No Poverty), SDG 2 (Zero Hunger), SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-being), and SDG 4 (Quality Education) to address global challenges.

The initiative included the distribution of 600 food packs and 170 winter packages, addressing immediate needs during the harsh winters.

Furthermore, the initiative encompassed the distribution of 2142+ school bags, 1428+ stationery packs, and 1599+ school shoes, benefiting numerous children in the region. Additionally, 450+ orphan gift packs were distributed, providing essential items for orphans in the community.



MF also facilitated 300 cataract surgeries at Farooq General Hospital in Murree, Takhbai Dar-ul-Shifa Hospital in Mardan, and Care Hospital in Bannu, KPK, catering to the urgent needs of the patients.




FOOD PROJECT

INTEGRATING 'MORALS & ETHICS' INTO MOAWIN CLASSROOMS



A one-day orientation workshop on "Morals & Ethics" was conducted for the teachers of MF-assisted school Gov. Elementary School Colony Shaukatabad, Nankana Sahib, on 29th November. Similarly, the training workshop was conducted at GGES, Ghazi Minara, and GHS, Mahmunwali in which 48 teachers from 19 MF-assisted schools of Sheikhpura participated.

These orientation workshops aim to enhance the capacity of teachers to impart morals and ethical values to students through activity-based learning strategies. The session concluded with the distribution of certificates and resource material designed by Moawin Foundation.



SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURAL DEVELOPMENT

The repair work includes various aspects, including infrastructure improvements and facility upgrades. DIGITAL SAFAR WITH TECHVALLEY

On December 14, 2023, an MoU was signed between Moawin Foundation and Tech Valley to launch the "Digital Safar" program in Moawin-adopted schools. This initiative targets students aged 8-14 years in Grades 6-8, aiming to empower them with crucial digital literacy skills, thereby preparing them for the future workforce. The collaborative project seeks to provide a meaningful learning experience that aligns with the evolving demands of the digital era. Through the "Digital Safar" program, students will gain valuable insights and proficiency in navigating the digital landscape, enhancing their overall educational journey.





Meeting with the Turkish Ambassador in Pakistan

Chairman Moawin Foundation, Admiral Asif Sandila, recently met with H.E. Prof Dr. Mehmet Pacaci, Ambassador of the Republic of Turkey in Pakistan.
