Life Skills Based Education Sessions in Baltistan Schools

Moawin Foundation recently conducted a life skills session as part of its LSBE initiative for students in Baltistan region. Led by Dr. Shujat Mesam, the session was held at three schools: Community School Nar Shigar, Community Girls Middle School Qumra Skardu, and Government Girls Middle School Tinjus Skardu. 220 students participated, engaging in group activities and exercises focused on essential life skills such as interpersonal relationships, self-awareness, and effective communication. The initiative aimed to equip students with the tools needed to navigate personal and social challenges, enhancing their overall development.

Women's Empowerment through Fruit Preservation in Gilgit-Baltistan

Moawin Foundation continues to empower women in Gilgit-Baltistan through its fruit drying and preservation project. In its second phase, women in both regions are receiving intensive training in mulberry and apricot dehydration, preservation techniques, and organic jam production, helping them develop valuable skills and secure sustainable livelihoods.

Professional Development of Teachers

Pedagogy Workshop at COMSATS University Attock Campus

The training focused on the 4 Cs of 21st-century skills: critical thinking, collaboration, communication, and creativity. Using low-cost materials, the teachers created innovative models and are eager to integrate real-world STEM education into their classrooms.

Teachers' Development Program in Collaboration with Sindh Education Foundation

From June 24th to July 8th, 2024, our dedicated teachers from Jamali Goth and Gadap participated in an intensive 15-day training program. Organized in collaboration with the Sindh Education Foundation, Government of Sindh, the program focused on improving teaching techniques in English, Science, and Math.
