MOAWIN FOUNDATION - SCHOOLS ACTIVITIES

Plantation Drive

Moawin Foundation has launched a nationwide plantation drive across various regions of Pakistan, engaging students, teachers, and local authorities to promote environmental sustainability and a greener future. The campaign began in the Attock cluster, covering **11 schools**, with the first activity held at **GBPS Dhok Fateh**, where Assistant Commissioner Attock, **Miss Anza Abbasi**, participated to support the cause. In **GGHS Rohtas**, students, teachers, and school council members came together to plant trees, fostering environmental awareness. The drive extended to **Sheikhupura**, where schools embraced the initiative, encouraging students to actively participate in conservation efforts. TRANSFORMING EARLY LEARNING

Establishment of 120 ECD Classrooms in Gilgit-Baltistan

Moawin Foundation, in collaboration with the School Education Department Gilgit-Baltistan and UNICEF, is establishing 120 quality Early Childhood Development (ECD) classrooms in government schools across the region. Focused on enhancing learning environments and building teacher capacity, the project has successfully completed work in six districts: **Gilgit, Hunza, Nagar, Ghizer, Skardu, and Shigar.**

Procurement of ECD materials for the first 30 schools is nearing completion, while teacher manuals and 30-week lesson plans have been developed, approved, and are currently being printed. With active engagement in ongoing districts and commendable coordination among field teams, the initiative is progressing efficiently and is on track to become a model intervention for early childhood education in Gilgit-Baltistan.
