Moawin Foundation Inaugurates Upgraded Facilities at IMS I-V G-9/2

Moawin Foundation Islamabad proudly hosted an inauguration ceremony at IMS I-V G-9/2 to unveil major school upgrades. 
Annual Examination Award Ceremony Held in Ghotki

The event brought together esteemed guests to celebrate his remarkable contributions to education and social development in Pakistan through the transformative work of the Moawin Foundation.




Moawin Foundation and NUST Explore Strategic Collaboration
